We aim to treat your child like one of our own, understand and appreciate your child as an individual and find out what makes them truly happy.




Providing a safe and welcoming environment where children can learn, make friends, explore different activities and more importantly feel like they can be themselves.




- ★ Managers either hold childcare degrees or have Children's Playwork Diplomas.






Can I book a free trial?

Absolutely! You are more than welcome to come and view our settings and also experience our camps before booking a full day. Just contact our team to book in your free four hour trial. (subject to availability)

Do you accept Childcare Vouchers and Tax Free Childcare?

Yes we do. We are partnered with many voucher schemes please just let us know which provider you plan to use. To make a payment via tax free childcare, please contact us for our Ofsted number.

My child is 4, can they attend?

Some of our settings are registered on the early years register which means we can accept 4 year olds for a full day. However, we do have camps without this registration at the moment meaning 4 year olds would be limited to four hours a day. Please contact us to enquire about your nearest camp.

Do you offer discounts?

We often run early bird discounts and sibling discounts too! (subject to change)

My child has additional needs, can they still attend?

Absolutely! It's always worth giving us a call beforehand if you're concerned to discuss whether our camp is suitable for your child.

Are you open every school holiday?

We are open every school holiday with the exception of bank holidays. We also close the week between Christmas and New Year so our team can enjoy time with their families.

*On the rare occasion our usual venue may not be available to us, we will try to relocate to a hall nearby.

Are the younger children separate to the older children?

The children are usually split into groups when in camp, each with their own staff member. The children have many activity choices and tend to group dependent on interests. We are extremely lucky that our older children are very sensible and welcoming of the younger ones, and all of our activities are designed to suit varying ages.

Do you provide lunch?

Please attend with a packed lunch and a bottled drink. The children will have access to drinking water throughout the day.

Do I have to drop off at the time I have booked?

You can drop your little one when suits you. There should always be a manager available to greet you when you arrive.

My child is new to camps, how will you ensure they settle in?

We are extremely lucky to welcome new families to camp every holiday and as parents we understand how it feels taking your little one to a new place for the first time. The staff are excellent at welcoming newbies and we have many ways help your little one feel comfortable.
